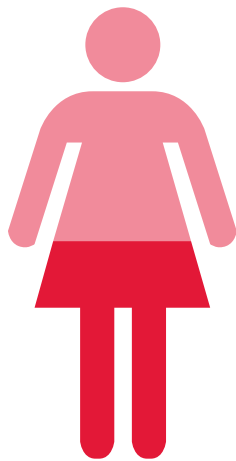

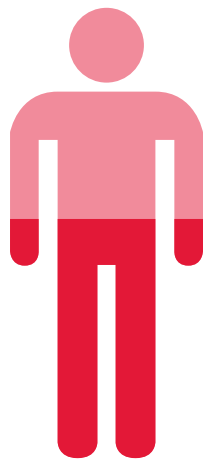

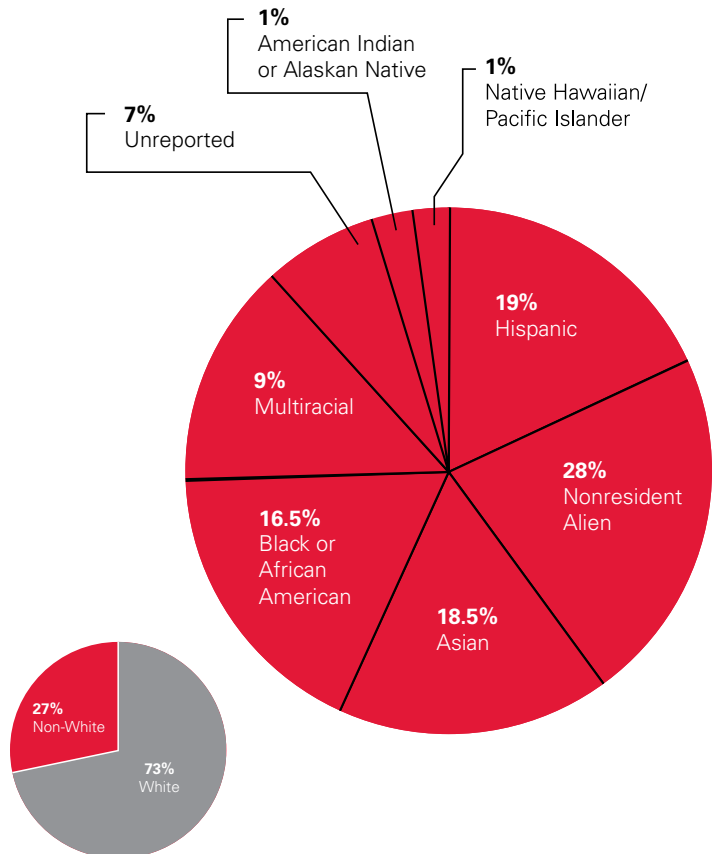

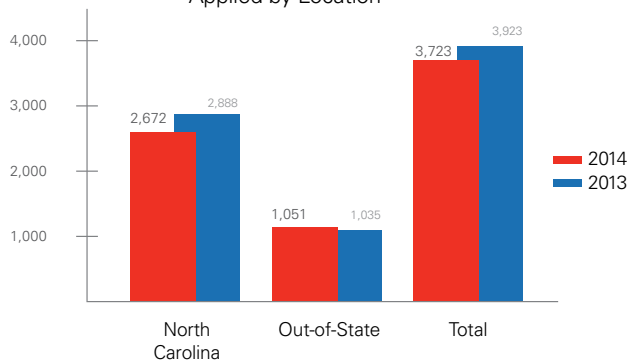
Class Profile

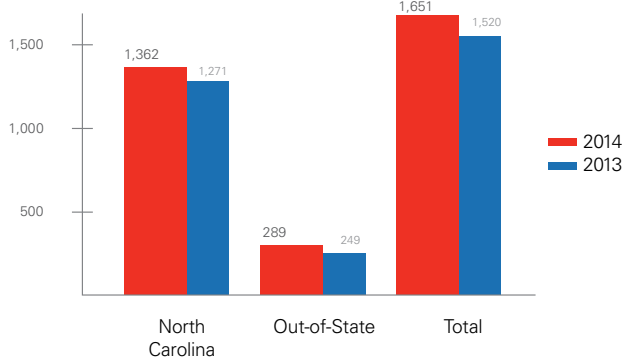

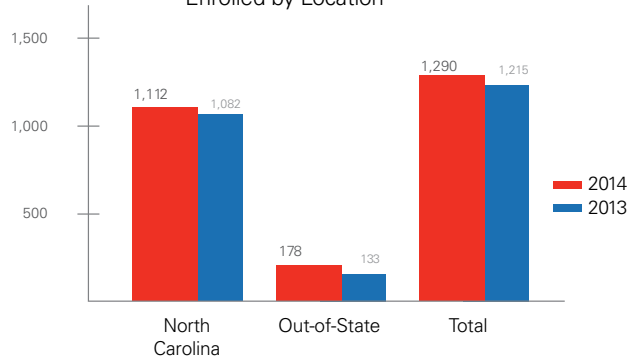
Applied by Location

Application Procedure

Through wolfPAW, NC State's Personal Admissions Website, students can create an online profile, register for campus visits and events, receive important reminders and announcements and apply to NC State.

A complete application includes:

- ▶ Non-refundable application fee (\$75 for domestic and \$100 for international undergraduate applications)
- ▶ Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR) – list of coursework and grades from high school and all college institutions attended including current courses in-progress
- ▶ Self-loaded unofficial transcript – final high school transcript from graduating high school uploaded through wolfPAW
- ▶ Self-loaded unofficial transcript from each college and/or university attended uploaded through wolfPAW

Please note: ACT or SAT scores are not required for transfer applicants who have completed more than 30 semester hours of transferable courses prior to applying. All AP or IB scores must be sent directly from the testing agency.

Only enrolling students will be required to submit official final transcripts from each institution attended.

Transfer Application Deadlines

Fall Semester

First Deadline: January 15

Notification Date: March 30

Final Deadline: March 15

Notification Date: May 15

Please note: A pending decision for some fall semester transfer applicants may require a transcript showing grades for completed coursework by June 1.

Spring Semester

Application Deadline: October 1

Notification Date: December 1
